Sunday March 20th

Two Temple Place. The exhibition theme is Ancient Egypt/Egyptology showing artefacts loaned by several museums and with an emphasis on items excavated during the Victorian period.

Sunday April 24th

Upton House & Gardens, Nr. Banbury. In 1939 the owners, the Bearsteds, moved out and their family-owned bank, M. Samuel & Co., moved in. Take a step back in time and see how the bank staff coped during the Second World War.

Sunday May 22nd

Eltham Palace, Greenwich. Given to Edward II in 1305 by the Bishop of Durham it was used by the crown from the 14th to 16th century and it was the childhood home of Henry VIII. The Courtaulds built an Art Deco residence next to the palace remains.

Sunday June 26th

Hardwick Hall, Chesterfield, Derbyshire. Regarded as an Elizabethan masterpiece created in the 1500's by the formidable Bess of Hardwick.

Sunday August 21st

Oxburgh Hall, Swaffham, Norfolk. Built in 1482 by the Catholic Bedingfeld family, explore the hidden doors and priest hole. The house cantains needlework by Mary, Queen of Scots and colourful wallpapers from the mid 19th century.

September

Three day tour in the North West visiting the two Liverpool Cathedrals, Port Sunlight & Lady Lever Art Gallery, Lowry Centre and Imperial War Museum of the North.

Sunday October 23rd

The Museum of London. A wide range of displays showing London's history and evolution over the centuries and the impact on its citizens.
