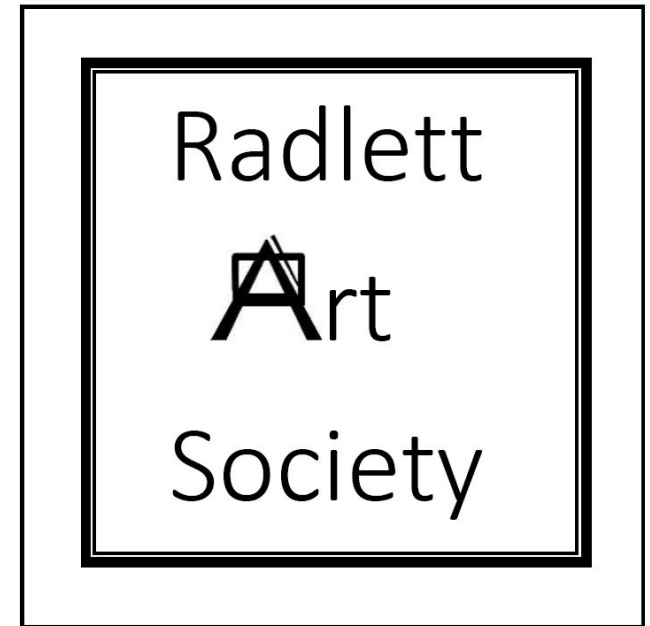
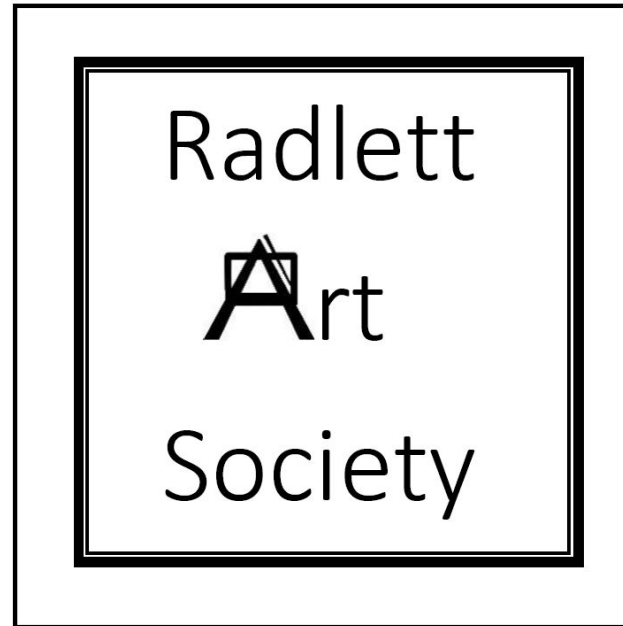

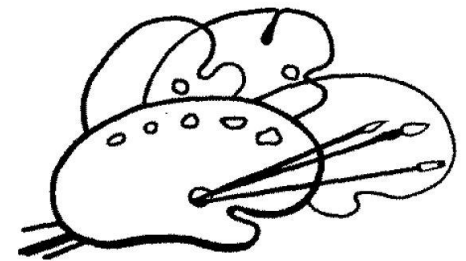
Our current annual subscription of £30 (student £10) represents excellent value for all the events the Society offers, so why not come and join those of us who have enjoyed this superb amenity for so long?
